## A Guide To Daily Prayers

Parishioners frequently ask us for advice on how to make personal prayer time for the Lord and how to pray. Here is a sample Morning Prayer and Night Prayer that can be recited daily. These prayers are taken from "Confirmed: A Treasury of Faith and Prayer". All prayer time before the Lord is good. Sitting silently in the Lord's presence, sharing your time and life with Him, is a prayer.




### Morning Prayer

O my God,  
I offer you all my thoughts, words,  
actions and sufferings;  
and I ask you to give me grace  
that I may not offend you today  
but may faithfully serve you  
and do your holy will in all things.  
I entrust myself completely  
to your mercy today and always.



Lord, may everything I do  
begin with your inspiration,  
continue with your help  
and reach conclusion under your  
guidance.



### Intercessions

Let us pray to Christ our Lord,  
the sun who enlightens all people:  
We thank you for the gift of this  
new day (pause)  
May your Holy Spirit guide us to do  
your will (pause)  
Help us to manifest your love to all  
those we meet (pause)  
Renew in us your gifts (pause)

### Concluding prayer

Almighty God you have given us  
this day; strengthen us with your  
power and keep us from falling into  
sin so that whatever we say or  
think or do we be in your service  
and for the sake of your kingdom,  
Amen.

### Night Prayer

O my God,  
I thank you for all the benefits  
which I have ever received from you  
and especially this day.  
Give me light to see what sins I have  
committed and grant me the grace to  
be truly sorry for them.  
(A brief examination of conscience)

### Intercessions

May your kingdom of peace and  
justice be realised on earth as in  
heaven:  
Show yourself to all who seek you in  
sincerity of heart (pause)  
Shine on those who walk in darkness  
and in the shadow of death (pause)  
Be with those who suffer in mind,  
body or spirit (pause)  
Show mercy to the dead, bring them  
to rejoice in the company of the  
Blessed Virgin Mary and all your  
saints (pause)

### Concluding prayer

Into your hands, O Lord,  
I commend my spirit:  
Lord Jesus, receive my soul.  
In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ  
crucified, I lay me down to rest.  
Bless me O Lord and defend me;  
Preserve me from a sudden  
and unprovided death and from all  
dangers and bring me to life  
everlasting with you, Amen.



## NATIONAL

### New Bishop of Ferns appointed

Fr Ger Nash was announced on Friday as the new Bishop of Ferns (Wexford). He succeeds Bishop Denis Brennan who has been in the role since 2006. His successor, 62-year-old Fr Nash, a priest of the Diocese of Killaloe, is originally from the parish of Tulla in Co Clare. Following his Leaving Certificate, he studied business and then worked in manufacturing industry for a number of years. After choosing to study in Saint Patrick's College Maynooth, he was ordained in 1991.

Following his ordination, Fr Nash was appointed as chaplain and teacher in Roscrea Vocational School and as priest responsible for Roscrea Youth Centre. In 1996 he was appointed as General Manager of ClareCare, which provides a range of social services to the people of Co Clare. In 2003, he was appointed as resident priest in Corofin and part of the first grouping of parishes in the Diocese of Killaloe. He became Diocesan Secretary in 2010 and Director of Pastoral Development in 2016.



## GLOBAL

### UK Bishops call for G7 leaders to act



Bishops in the UK called on the G7 to “build back a fairer, greener, global economy”. The bishops made three recommendations for G7 leaders:

- Provide economic support towards a sustainable recovery from the pandemic, and to move quickly to halt the biodiversity loss the planet is facing;
- support developing nations, ensuring that they have fair access to vaccines;
- and ensure sustained action so that the world doesn't exceed the 1.5°C temperature rise “beyond which life on our planet will face dire consequences.”

## Covid-19 Guidelines
