Gospel reading from St Matthew for the Remembrance Mass

Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and precede him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. After doing so, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray. When it was evening he was there alone.

Meanwhile the boat, already a few miles offshore, was being tossed about by the waves, for the wind was against it. At dawn, Jesus came toward them, walking on the sea.

Final hymn for Remembrance Mass

Amazing Grace! how sweet the sound
That saved a wretch like me
I once was lost, but now am found
Was blind but now I see.

Through many dangers, toils, and snares

This hymn was written by a former slave trader, John Newton in 1773. The powerful opening line drew on his near-death experience, when the slave ship he was on encountered a violent storm, prompting him to convert to Christianity and then to speak out against slavery.

South Africa rugby captain led by Christ

South Africa's rugby team captain, who led his team to victory, is a man dedicated to Christ. Siya Kolisi led the Springboks' in their historic win against England. Writing in SportGoMag in September of this year he said "While struggling with a lot of things personally - temptations, sins and lifestyle choices - I realised I wasn't living according to what I was calling myself: a follower of Christ. I was getting by, but I hadn't decided to fully commit myself to Jesus Christ and start living according to his way".



Mr Kolisi grew up in difficult circumstances in Zwide where he was raised by his grandmother because his parents were too young to look after him.

Growing up in poverty he started playing rugby when he was eight, describing it as something that "seemed to keep me away from a lot of the bad things going on around me".

"Walking with a spiritual mentor, I've been able to discover the truth and saving power of Christ in a whole new way. This new life has given me a peace in my heart I'd never experienced before. "Now that I have given everything to God, nothing else affects me. I now live and play with the freedom of knowing His plan will always happen, and at the end of the day, that's all I care about".
